Note 1

MRA - COMPENSATION SECTIONS (see Note 3 also for all compensation matters)

85(5) – Application by party to have Tribunal determine amount of compensation and the terms, conditions and times of payment thereof for mining claim.

85(12) – Referral by MR to Tribunal to determine amount of compensation for mining claim in certain circumstances.

279(5) – Referral by MR to determine amount of compensation for mining lease.

281 – Application by party to Tribunal to determine amount of compensation and the terms, conditions and times of payment thereof for mining lease.

For all compensation matters you must note on the fax to the Tribunal whether:

- (a) you have doubts about the identity of the owner of the land the subject of the application for a mining claim or mining lease; or
- (b) the owner of the land the subject of the application for a mining claim or mining lease cannot be found.

Pursuant to ss587 and 283, the Tribunal may determine that the Public Trustee should represent the owner.

MRA - APPEALS PROVISIONS

39 – Appeal by person adversely affected by Mining Registrar's decision about prospecting permit.

INTERIM ORDER BY REMOTE MEANS

364 – Application for interim order to detain or preserve property the subject of litigation – made to MR by reason of distance, urgency, etc.

599 – Appeals by person adversely affected by officer's decision with respect to a fossicking licence on a fossicker's camping permit.
